PURPOSE:

The Arizona Criminal Justice Commission will use the funds for three projects: Juvenile Online Tracking System (JOLTS) integration, Adult Probation Information System, and the Automated Order of Protection File. JOLTS will provide juvenile probation information to any Arizona criminal justice practitioner within the state's criminal justice system. The Adult Probation Information System will provide accurate and timely adult probation information, including probationary status and conditions, to any law enforcement user or prosecutor. The Automated Order of Protection File will enable the court system to electronically provide order of protection information to law enforcement within 24 hours of issuance.
