PURPOSE:

The Kansas Bureau of Investigation will use the funds to transform its Total Offender Activity Documentation System (TOADS) into a Web-based application so it can be accessed by other criminal justice agencies. The Web-based application will allow law enforcement officers, prosecutors, and the courts to access complete parole and probation information on offenders. In addition, the funds will be used for research and development that will lead to the establishment of a method for all authorized agencies to search all available databases regardless of the criminal justice agency or database vendor.
