#### Hardware and Software

Internet access and wireless access cards WILL NOT BE REQUIRED for the workshop. Plan to bring your laptop and an extra laptop battery for in-class exercises because there will not be access to an electrical plug at every seat. Software required for the workshop includes the current version of Microsoft Internet Explorer, Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Notepad, and either Adobe Acrobat or Adobe Reader. To avoid the need for Internet access on-site, workshop documents will be available on the Global JXDM Web site for review and downloading prior to the workshop. A "Workshop Documents and Downloads" page will be created soon and an update will be sent out with the Web page address and a link to the page. Participants should download all of the files from this page prior to the event so they can read ahead and have these files available for the class. Participants are encouraged to check the page frequently for any last minute updates, instructions, and/or file downloads.
